The assigned text for this week from the Gospel of Mark offers several directions for preaching, but something struck me when I read the part about Jesus going back to his hometown and preaching in the synagogue. It seems they reject him as a teacher, because they only see him as the carpenter they've always

known-the boy who grew up right in the midst of them. I guess this is where we get the term, "Familiarity breeds contempt."

What this means is that Jesus experienced failure in his ministry! So, how does that translate to our own ministry as individual disciples of Christ, and as a congregation? It means that failure at some level is inevitable, but that it

Your new name tag will be in the drawers under the counter in the narthex beginning Sunday, July 8.

We are excited to have an easy way to does not mean we are to quit! Jesus certainly did not quit when he faced this moment of failure. If you read the Gospels, you will see that there are other examples of Jesus failing to convince everyone with his message. And the greatest symbol of failure is the cross, if you think about it in these terms. What must have Jesus' followers thought as they saw him DEAD on that cross? Failure!

But the other side of this lesson is that God can take what we might deem as failure and turn it into success, even when we can't see it. The resurrection and the victory of eternal life came from the apparent failure of Jesus on the cross.

So, I think the practical application here is that we, too, will not always succeed in our ministry. There will be failures. But rather than pack it in and give up, we should allow God to use that failure, not to make us feel inadequate, but to guide us into a different direction. Our purpose of sharing the Gospel and serving others in Christ's name will never fail, but there will be times when our plans on how to do that might not be the direction our Lord wants us to take. So we seek the guidance of the Holy Spirit, alter course, and try it from a different direction. This gives me courage to persevere in my ministry, and to look at the times I fail, not as punishment or an indicator that I'm a failure, but as direction by the Holy Spirit to a different approach.

I hope that every person who receives this newsletter, and who is unable to come this Sunday to hear more, will take time to go to our website and listen to or read the sermon. God has a very encouraging message about perseverance that should give us a healthier perspective on taking calculated chances in ministry for the sake of the Gospel.

#### TWO NEW ADDITIONS TO OUR PRAYER MINISTRY:




New Members, **Tom & Sandy Martin** have agreed to coordinate the Prayer Ministry Team. We are blessed by their commitment to this important ministry!
