FIRST READING: Daniel 10:10-14; 12:1-3

SECOND READING: Revelation 12:7-12

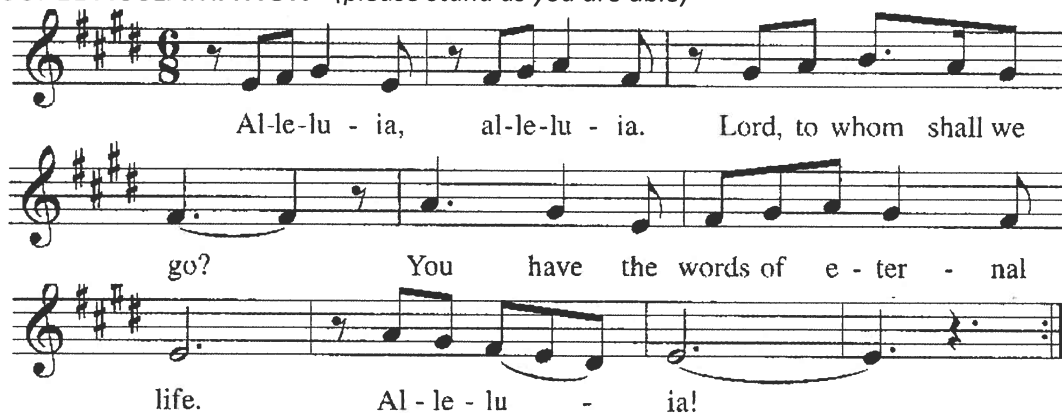
