Patience is hard for us as citizens and as disciples, but we also know that this is what we must do to protect each other.

I suspect that our getting back together for worship and other church activities will need to take place slowly. Of course, I have no idea since I'm living day to day like everyone else, but I wonder if our early coming together for worship might be done through several worship services on a Sunday with limited numbers of people in each. Perhaps before that, we might be able to have a service outside with communion distributed in a responsible manner. There are both many possibilities and also many limitations.

I wanted to thank you for being a valued partner with us through the COVID-19 pandemic. 
