From Pastor Mary

Dear Church,

Greetings from your church home! We are looking forward to several new things happening this week. One is the Thursday Soup Kitchen. Thanks to all who have volunteered to help in several ways. We have laid the groundwork and signed the paperwork to be a feeding agency with the United Way organization "Second Helpings" to assist us with this new ministry.

I have a personal ministry that will be officially launching next week. It's the

website and app I call "My Pocket Preacher". It contains my regular weekly blog "Ponder Anew", a short Bible study, a Prayer Board on the app, a study series just on the website, a podcast called "Walking With", and some random quotes and comments for reflection called "Breadcrumbs". I designed it especially for people who are not connected to a faith community, who have stepped away from one, or folks who have never been part of a religious community but who have questions about the Bible, about faith, about life, and about God. Once it launches, I'd be honored if you would refer it to people in your life who might appreciate it.

I thought you might be interested in the podcast I recorded last week with CLC Associate Member, Pastor Danny Wheeler, about his experience as the last survivor pulled from the bombing of the Marine barracks in Beirut in 1983. This Wednesday, I'll be talking to Pastor Jackie Utley in Columbia, SC, about her experience in these days of heightened racial tensions. She and I have worked together for several years on issues around race and the church. As a Black Lutheran woman, her insights and perspectives are ones we need to hear.
