Over the last couple of months, we have been working at Christ Lutheran to develop our music program and the staff that will make that happen. The Council and Worship Team decided to divide the music position up in to three roles: the Music Coordinator, the Technical Worship Producer, and a Piano/Organ/Keyboardist (which could be several different people). We have found our Technical Worship Producer (Garrett Keyes), and now we are pleased to announce that we have hired a new Music Coordinator, **our own Tami Kuhlmann!**

Tami earned a Masters of Arts in Sacred Music in 2018 from Trinity Lutheran Seminary at Capital University in Ohio. She understands the Lutheran liturgy and traditional Lutheran music in addition to being knowledgeable about more non-traditional approaches to church music. She has demonstrated her passion for developing different approaches during the past several years at Christ Lutheran with much success. Tami has experience overseeing church choirs, musicians, and bell choirs in rehearsals and music selection and she has a unique understanding of Christ Lutheran and an appreciation of our history, which means that she can begin her work immediately without much orientation.

Tami has several trips that were planned earlier, but she has already started this past week meeting with the pastor, making music selections, and organizing the music room to get us ready for the fall. The First step will be to find one or several people who can play the piano, organ, and keyboard on a regular basis.

We are excited to have Tami start her work with us and to move into the future with our music ministry!
