


# The Bridge June 17, 2022

#### SYNOD ASSEMBLY

Our time at the Synod Assembly was fairly uneventful, which is probably a good thing. (Carol had some trouble with her car, but she can tell you those details.) But otherwise, the time was as expected. We learned a lot about ministries of the Synod. We saw videos about congregations who were Reconciling in Christ. We supported a ministry that offered housing for those getting out of rehab, we heard about the importance for telling the story of our own church, and we heard some great story telling from a story-telling pastor Mary Caniff-Kuhn. We voted on budgets and Synod Council Members, and we voted on resolutions. The one thanking the History Team passed without discussion, and the Death Penalty one passed with little discussion. We worshipped at St. Matthew's Church in

downtown Charleston which is an impressive structure. There was a great organ and choir (which our own Susie Fidler sang in as you can see in the picture above!)

It was good to be around people and to see the larger church. We also sat with Pr. Mary (our former interim) who sends her regards to everyone! (seen in the picture below.)




### GIVING DURING THE SUMMER
