We know that everyone can't come to all the sessions, but we hope if you're in town and available, that you will make every effort to come!






# NOTES FROM THE PRESCHOOL

"Family Promise of Beaufort County is planning to restart our congregational model starting the first week in September 2022. We currently have 11 weeks already booked. Additionally, we have six weeks scheduled for 2023."

Christ Lutheran will be hosting two weeks in November: November 6-20,

2022. We will once again be partnering with Hilton Head Is. Community Church and St. Francis Catholic Church. We are excited to restart our participation in the program and provide housing and food for folks who are looking to get back on their feet and better their lives.

It takes MANY volunteers to make the weeks run smoothly. We will be signing people up the first of October to help with providing meals, contributing supplies, staying over night, mid-stay and final washing of sheets and blankets, set up and take down of the inflatable beds used by the guests. 
