

Thousands of people are under evacuation orders, some moving to other Hawaiian islands. Wildfires have also affected the Big Island of Hawaii, and the islands remain vulnerable to more fires this season.

MALAWI MINISTRY OF HOPE


Malawi has been a global outreach for CLC since 2014
