

### !NEW! CAREGIVER SUPPORT GROUP



Are you caring for someone? An elderly parent? A spouse? Someone with a long-term disability or illness? Caring for someone presents many daily challenges and can be a heavy load to carry.

The purpose of our CLC caregiver support group is to identify caregiver-related stress and help to bring awareness to

psychological, physical, behavioral, and social problems among caregivers and care receivers.

One of the main benefits of caregiver support groups is that they provide muchneeded social support.

Support group members can validate each other's experiences. It's a relief to know that what you're going through is normal and that you're not the only one with these feelings – negative or positive

Support groups are also a great place to ask for advice, find out about useful resources, or vent frustrations.

You won't have to worry about judgement or confusion from non-caregivers since everyone is going through similar struggles.

# Did you know that Christ Lutheran Church has an Endowment Fund? We do!

An endowment is a special fund that is used as an investment for the congregation. We use the ELCA's Mission Investment Fund to manage our endowment. The principle fund of our endowment is not used but it is allowed to grow over time. The returns we receive on the investment are then used to provide for special non-budgeted

projects that will help our mission and improve our congregation.

Many people give to a church's endowment in memory of loved ones. People also give to the endowment through planned, intentional giving from their estates. People who give this way can derive tax benefits by giving from their Required Minimum Distributions or other sources of personal income. Also, members who no longer have active beneficiaries often choose to give a church's Endowment as an option for their acquired assets.

There is free financial planning advice on these ways to give to CLCL's Endowment fund through the ELCA's Gift and Legacy Advisor. The ELCA advisor can work with your current financial planner to achieve your desired results. (Contributions to the church are <u>not</u> a requirement for the advisors participation and their compensation comes from the ELCA.)

When you give to an endowment, you are giving to the long-term stability and longevity of our congregation. Your gifts can serve the mission of Christ Lutheran Church on Hilton Head for years to come!
