

Please be part of this colorful festival to show the LGBTQ community and its allies that we wholeheartedly support and love them!


Come out and celebrate with us! Port Royal is worth a visit!



!NEW! CAREGIVER SUPPORT GROUP



Are you caring for someone? An elderly parent? A spouse? Someone with a long-term disability or illness? Caring for someone presents many daily challenges and can be a heavy load to carry.

The purpose of our CLC caregiver support group is to identify caregiver-related stress and help to bring awareness to

psychological, physical, behavioral, and social problems among caregivers and care receivers.

One of the main benefits of caregiver support groups is that they provide much-needed social support.

Support group members can validate each other's experiences. It's a relief to know that what you're going through is normal and that you're not the only one with these-feelings-negative or positive

Support groups are also a great place to ask for advice, find out about useful resources, or vent frustrations.

You won't have to worry about judgement or confusion from non-caregivers since everyone is going through similar struggles.
