Stewardship 2024

Our stewardship drive is starting this week and will go through February 11th. Will offer our Statement of Intent cards on February 4th

During Epiphany, we will hear sermons about giving and generosity from me, **Pr. June**, and from **Rev. Rick Klotz, Rev. Julie Raino, and Rev. Rick Carter,** assistant to the bishop for the South Carolina Synod.

During those four weeks we will be focusing on **Mark 12:38-44**, the story of the Widow's Mite. Over the four weeks, will hear that story four times (with Judy Wilfong doing Gospel Story Telling) and we will hear four different takes from our four different preachers on this story. (Trust me, there's enough in that story for lots of sermons!)

During worship you will also be hearing short Moments of Generosity from our members.

The people of Christ Lutheran are generous. There are many people who support the ministry of this congregation with their generous, consistent giving. Food Pantry!

Our plans are moving ahead with our food distribution with Second Helping for Chimney Cove and other Hilton Head residents!

We are scheduled to start on Thursday, January 18th (4-5:30pm.) That's not far off!

This will be a project the whole church can really get involved in in different ways!



Hand Trucks - We need your hand trucks! (pictured here) We know someone has one! If a few people could bring hand trucks to the church, we'd like to borrow them until we establish what we need and get our own. (We'll give it back, we promise.)

Bags - We need your plastic grocery bags! Those plastic bags that we have no idea what to do with, bring them to church! We'll have a receptacle of some sort in the Ministry Lobby for Sunday.

Time TBA <u>Thursdays</u> - If you'd like to volunteer to help distribute food, please let us know. And on **Thursday**, **January 18th**, **we'll need all hands on deck!** We don't know how many people will be coming for food and we don't yet know how it's going to work, so we'd rather have lots of people standing around than not enough people! **Please arrive at 3pm**.

share the pain and suffering as well as the joys and hopes that life still has to offer.


