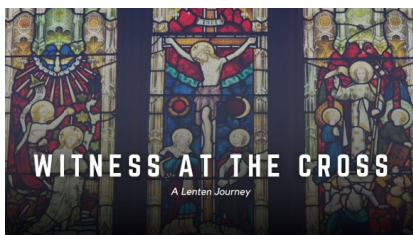

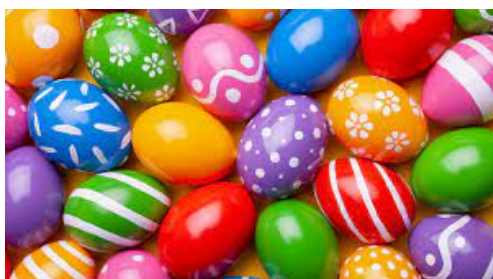

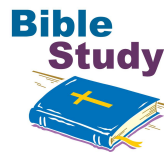

May God move us through the witness of our biblical ancestors to faith that glorifies God.

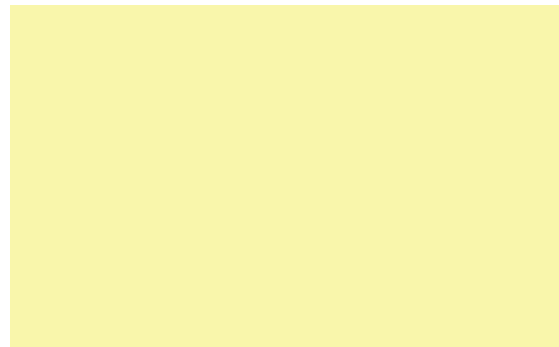
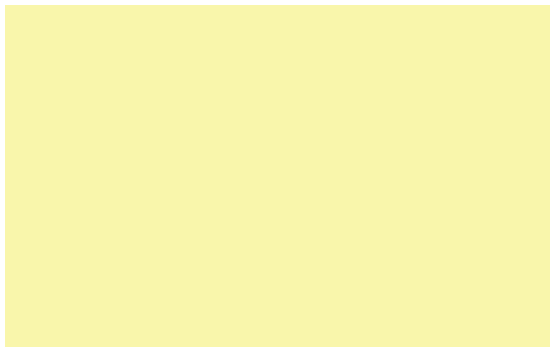
